

# Homework policy

The following, revised homework policy was recently passed by the Governing Body.

We would like to inform you of the most important points, but a more complete copy may be requested from the teacher or the HOD.

## Foundation Phase

- **Grade 1 and 2:** They get a printed copy of the weekly homework which is stuck in their diaries.
- **Grade 3:** They copy the homework from the board.
- **Teachers check the diaries daily.**
- **It is the responsibility of the parents to ensure that diaries are signed and packed into their child's school bag for the next day.**

## Intersen Phase (Grade 4 – 7)

- **Learners must take home their English, Maths and Afrikaans books on a daily basis.**
- **Learners will know which classwork needs to be completed at home.**
- **When teachers do their weekly marking of books, they will put an "incomplete" stamp in the book if work is not completed.**
- **Learners may write a reminder for themselves in their diaries, but these will not be checked by the teacher.**
- **Parents need to be aware of the Planning and Assessment Programme and need to engage with their children on a daily basis with regard to their school work.**
- **Learners will also be regularly reminded by teachers about assessments and project due dates.**
