

## **SPORT**

### **Foundation Phase**

1. The Gr 1,2 and 3 teachers will accompany their cricketers to the changing rooms where they will assist and maintain discipline.
2. The teachers will then take the cricketers to meet the coach.
3. The teachers will do the attendance register. A clipboard with the names for each age group, will be available from the coach.
4. If a child is not present and was not absent on the day, the teacher will investigate to the cause of the absenteeism.
5. The teachers will settle the players and assure that discipline is maintained.
6. If a match is to be played, the teachers will follow the same procedure, but will accompany the players to the bus and assure that the players getting on the bus, corresponds with the names provided by the coach for those fixtures.

### **Intersen Phase**

1. The Gr 4 teacher will still accompany the learners – as above.
2. The older children (Gr 5 and above) will meet their coach on the field for practice and the coach will assure that the correct players use the busses when matches are played.

## **GENERAL: SPORT**

Learners should always be dressed in the correct attire for the particular sporting code.

Coaches and teacher assistants should ensure that good discipline is maintained at all time and report any incidents of misbehaviour to the class teacher and the principal.

The skill of sportmanship should be encouraged and developed continuously.
